

QUINCY THE QUAIL © PAPER PLATE CRAFT

SUPPLIES:

White paper plate
Black construction paper
Crayons and/or colored pencils
Black pipe cleaners
Googly eyes
Feathers
Scissors
Craft glue or hot glue gun

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut the paper plate in half
2. Cut a teardrop shape for the wing from the remaining paper plate piece
3. Use a saltshaker or other small circular object to trace a circle on the black construction paper. As you cut the quail's head, make a pointed portion of the head for the beak
4. Color the body of the quail using red, orange, yellow, blue, and purple. Draw lots of letter U's to make the feathers on the body of the quail
5. Color the wing and draw some letter U's for the feathers
6. Cut one pipe cleaner into three pieces: two 3-inch pieces for the legs and one 2-inch piece for the topknot. Bend the two 3-inch pieces at about 1 inch.
7. Glue the following pieces on the body of the quail:
 - a. Wing
 - b. Head
 - c. Googly eye
 - d. Tail
 - e. Topknot
 - f. Legs
